The candidate should have a minimum **educational qualification of Class VIII Standard** and should possess a valid **Professional Driving Licence**. The candidate should not be more than **38 years of age and less than 18 years** as on the last date of submission of application. The upper age limit will be relaxed up to 5 (five) years in case of candidates belonging to SC/ST.
